

SECOND U.S. HWY. 90/MAHAN DRIVE CONSTRUCTION PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING



The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled a Second Construction Public Information Meeting regarding improvements to State Road 10 (U.S. Hwy. 90/Mahan Drive) located in Leon County.
